

# **FAO-BCC Project on Guidance on Institutional Arrangements Which Support an Ecosystem Approach to Fisheries Management in the Benguela Current Commission area**

## *Terms of Reference for a National Consultant*

### **Background**

The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) is collaborating with the Benguela Current Commission (BCC) to implement a project that seeks to provide guidance on institutional arrangements for the management of fisheries resources in Angola, Namibia and South Africa in accordance with the ecosystem approach to fisheries. A National consultant is required to assist this work. The Terms of Reference of the consultancy are as follows:

Under the overall supervision of EAF-Nansen Project Coordinator and in close collaboration:

1. Liaise with the international consultant to:
  - Gather relevant information requested by the international consultant
  - Prepare a draft national report to be used as input for consultations by the international consultant
  - Finalise national report with comments from the international consultant.
2. Organise and participate in the national workshop.

**Qualifications:** The incumbent should have an advanced degree in marine science, fisheries, socio-economics, natural resources, biology, or equivalent discipline in relation with fisheries management, with at least 10 years of relevant experience in fisheries management and governance, including experience with institutional development and international cooperation.
